## Stqarrija ta' Louis Galea dwar ir-rapport tal-Bord tal-Inkjestha Mater Dei

Sa l-elezzjoni ta' Ottubru 1996 jiena kont il-Ministru tas-saħħa u chairman tal-FMSS\* tul l-ewwel fażi tal-bini tal-isptar. Jiena diga' weġibt għal mistoqsijiet li l-bord ħass li kelle jagħmilli fid-9 ta' April 2015.

Jien nappoġġja kull sforz li jista' jwassal biex min kelle x'jaqsam ma' azzjonijiet frawdolenti fil-provvista u l-ittejtjar ta' konkrit ta' kwalità inferjuri jinżamm responsabbi.

Filwaqt li beħsiebni nibqa' nikkopera mal-awtoritajiet rispettivi fl-investigazzjonijiet li jistgħu jagħmlu, kuntrajament ghall-konklużjonijiet jew insinwazzjonijiet tar-rapport, nistqarr kategorikament li taħt ir-responsabbilita' tiegħi:

- l-FMSS u l-Gvern ma kellhom l-ebda għarfien tal-allegat frodi;
- il-Gvern, il-bord tal-FMSS u jien agixxejna b'diligenza u safejn kien ragjonevolment u oggettivament possibli assigurajna li jkun hemm f'postu u jithaddem qafas ta' kontroll adegwat;
- qatt ma kien hemm xi kollużjoni minni, jew safejn naf jien minn xi membru tal-bord tal-FMSS fiż-żmien li fih jien kont involut, f'xi att impropriju jew illegali kif ir-rapport jittenta jimplika fil-konklużjoni 5 tiegħu.

Waqt li l-esperjenza kollha turi li hemm lezzjonijiet x'nitgħallmu biex sitwazzjonijiet bħal dawn jiġu evitati fil-futur, wieħed m'għandux jistenna li tintrefa' responsabbilita' politika għal frodi li l-awtoritajiet bl-ebda mod ma jkunu jafu bi. Il-frodi min natura tiegħu stess hu magħmul biex iċarraaq u biex jevita il-kontrolli stabbiliti u għandu jiġi perseggwitat bis-shiħ. Għaldaqstant, ir-responsabilita' f'dan il-każ għandha tingħarr minn dawk li allegatament ipprovdew jew ittestjaw b'mod frawdolenti konkrit ta' kwalita' inferjuri.

Jien beħsiebni nkompli nikkolabora mal-awtoritajiet f'harsien shiħ tal-ligħiġiet ta' Malta.

Qiegħed nagħmel din l-istqarrija bla preġudizzju għar-riservi tiegħi fuq l-inkiesta nnifisha, n-nuqqas ta' baži għal certu stqarrijiet magħmula minn numru ta' xhieda, u għan-nuqqas ta' evidenza li fuqha r-rapport jibbażza certi konklużjonijiet, kif ukoll bla preġudizzju għal xi investigazzjoni li tista' qed issir b'konnessjoni mal-każ.

**Statement by Louis Galea on the report of the Mater Dei Inquiry Board**

Up to the election of October 1996 I was the Minister for health and the chairman of the FMSS\* during the first phase of construction of the hospital. I have already answered the questions that the Board put to me on the 9 April 2015.

I fully support all endeavour to hold those responsible to account for any fraudulent actions in the supply or testing of poor quality concrete.


While I remain fully available to co-operate with the respective authorities in such investigations, contrary to the report's conclusions or insinuations, I categorically state that under my watch:

- the FMSS and the Government did not know of the alleged fraud;
- Government, the FMSS board and myself acted diligently and as reasonably and objectively as possible to ensure that an adequate control framework was in place and implemented;
- no collusion at all ever existed by myself, or to my knowledge by the members of the FMSS board at the time I was involved, in any improper or illegal act as the report attempts to imply in conclusion 5 of its report.

While the whole experience shows that there are lessons to be learnt to prevent such situations in the future, one cannot expect political responsibility to be borne for fraud which is completely unknown to the political authorities. Fraud by its very nature is intended to deceive or override controls and should be unreservedly pursued. As a result, responsibility in this case should be borne by those allegedly involved in the fraudulent supply or testing of poor quality concrete.

I will continue to collaborate fully with the authorities in full compliance with the laws of Malta.

I am releasing this comment without prejudice to my reservations on the inquiry itself, the lack of evidence backing up certain statements made by a number of witnesses, and the evidence backing up certain conclusions expressed by the board of inquiry, and without prejudice to any investigations that might be ongoing on the case.
